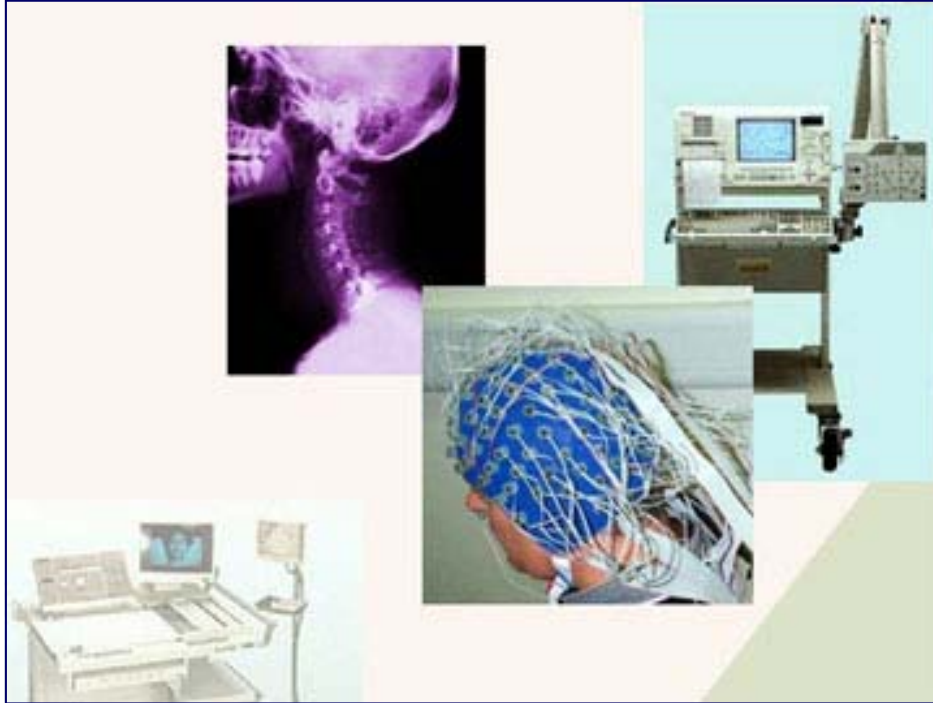


Your life depends on a healthy heart.

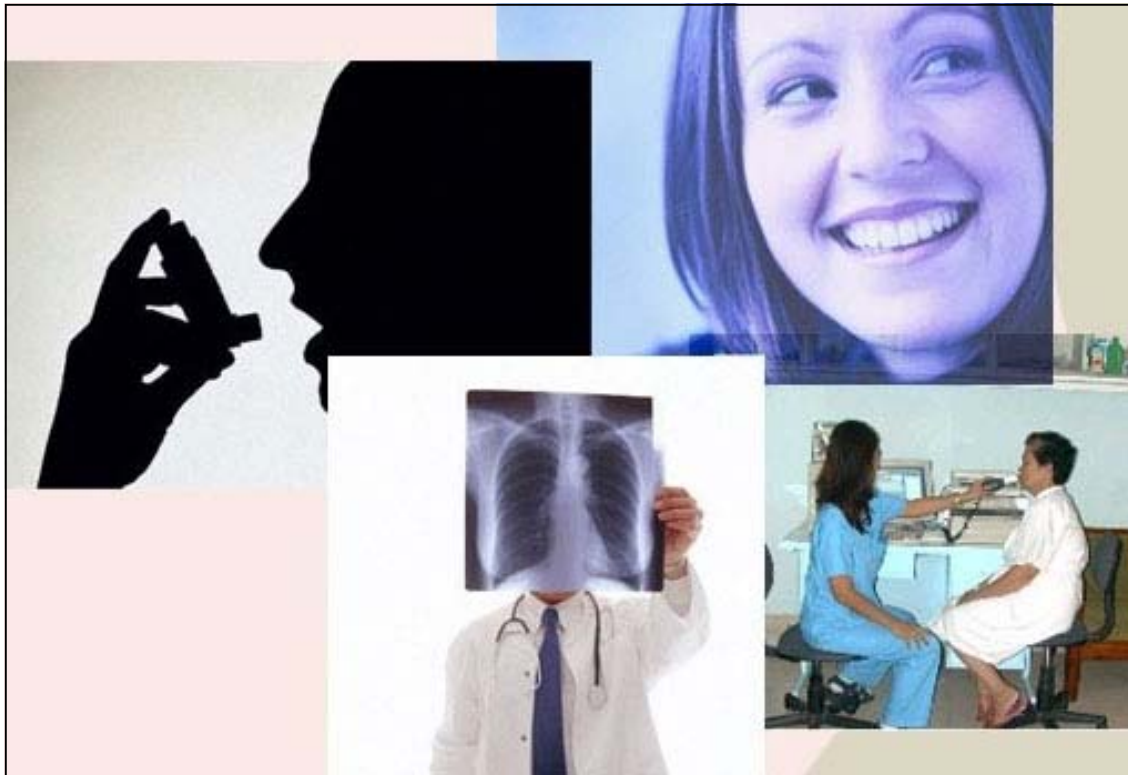
